Dear Parents/Carers,

The children and staff have begun their Christmas Nativity rehearsals in earnest and I am sure you will all enjoy the performances.

This year our Choirs will be performing in the community (using our new music system purchased by the PTA); you are all welcome to come along, the dates are:

- The Staff and Parent Choir will be performing at The Mansion House, Calderstones Park on **Sunday 30th November** from 1pm to 2pm.
- The Year Two Seasonal Choir will be performing outside St George's Hall, Liverpool City Centre **Tuesday 16th December** at 5pm.
- The Year Two Seasonal Choir will also be performing at The Mansion House, Calderstones Park on **Wednesday 17th December** from 1pm- 1.30pm.

Nativity Performances

The PTA sell class photographs of the children when they're dressed up for their Nativity Performances. The photographs are sold on the day of the individual performances for £1. Next week we will be taking the photographs, so we ask that the children bring in their costumes by **Monday 24th December** at the latest. We do not have a card machine for payments, cash will therefore be needed for any photographs purchased.

In previous years we charged for Nativity tickets and hot drinks, however this year we will have a voluntary donation point at the performances.

Each family can decide which performance they wish to attend, either two people at 9.30am or two people at 2.15pm, or one at each. Ms Young and Mrs Robinson will mark your attendance on a class register. You do not need to tell us which performance you will be attending, please remember only two people per family will be admitted during the course of the two performances.
