Dear Parents/Carers,

The Nursery and Reception children have been very good at lunchtime and have quickly learned the lunchtime routine. The meals are freshly prepared by Mr Rob and his team following the 'Food for Thought' weekly menu. The menu for the week ahead is posted on the Dining Room window and main door window. Monday is always 'meat free' and Quorn and Halal options are offered as well as an alternative choice. Reception children are offered milk with their meals. All the children in school take their water bottles into the hall at lunchtime. The school receives fruit daily as part of the free fruit in school scheme and this is offered to all the children in school. We ask that children do not bring snacks into school.

Celebration Assembly

The Reception children joined us for Celebration Assembly today, their behaviour was wonderful, so now they will be joining us each week. If your child has achieved in an activity outside of school, they can come to assembly on a Friday to share that achievement. Some examples of things we share are certificates, medals, badges and belts in sport, dance, drama or music. Special family events are shared as well. The children love to show and tell.
