Mr Dillon's Class 2D, Miss Prince's Class 1L, Miss Bayliss/Miss Gowland's Class RH
- The far right (green mats) **Nursery Class**

- The First Aid point and toilet will be via the Sensory Room Door on the right-hand side of the yard. This will be covered by a member of the school team.
- Audience can sit on the chairs provided or stand to watch the performances.

When the performance ends the children will return to their classrooms with their teachers. If you wish to take your child home after the concert they will be dismissed from their classroom.

Miss Tracey's Dance Class, Mr Thorpe's Year 1 Multi-Sport and Out of Hours Afterschool sessions will still take place on these dates.
