Dear Parents/Carers,

New School Communication System

From **Friday June 12th**, we will no longer use our existing school communication platform and will be moving to a communication platform called Arbor (this will coincide with the launch of our new school website on Monday June 15th).

In order to continue to receive communication from school, **you will need to login to Arbor**. A welcome email (from Arbor) with login instructions was sent via email yesterday afternoon. When you have successfully logged into the Arbor Parent Portal on the website, you can download the Arbor Parent App.

Please note, you **MUST** login for the first time on the **website** - you can only use the app when you have already logged into the website first. The welcome email from Arbor has been sent to all parents/carers who currently receive emails from us. Please check your spam folder if you do not see this in your inbox.

Important:

Please can you ensure that **BOTH guardians with parental responsibility** (e.g. mother and father) are added to Arbor. You can do this from within the Arbor website / Arbor app. Please note, guardians cannot see personal details for other guardians, even if they live at the same address. Guardians can only see the child's details.

When you add an additional guardian, if you wish them to have access to the Arbor app and receive app messages, **please ensure that you select YES for Primary Guardian**. If they wish to receive *emails only*, and *do not* require their own login to Arbor, you can select NO for Primary Guardian.

If you are having any issues with Arbor, please telephone the school office. We thank you in advance for your patience while we migrate to the new system!
