Dear Parents/Carers,

Last week we resumed the Star of the Week badges. One child from each class is chosen by the class adults to be Star of the Week. In Friday assembly they receive their star badge. This is one of a range of rewards we have school including:

- In class the children receive stamps on their stamper card for effort and achievement, working through a bronze, silver and gold award.
- Stickers are also awarded by different members of the school community.
- On an individual basis at lunchtime the children can receive a Golden Ticket for kindness and good manners. The tickets then go into the Golden Ticket box and we draw tickets each Friday for a small reward.
- You may hear your child talking about nuggets in the nugget jar. Nuggets are given out by all adults in school for good manners, helpful acts and kindness. The nuggets go in the class nugget jar and when it is full the class can choose a treat.
- The Headteacher's Award is given out to one pupil who has been a Superstar that week. Members of staff can nominate children to the Headteacher.

Parking

As you are aware Booker Avenue and the surrounding roads can become very congested at the start and the end of the school day. Several neighbours and parents have contacted the schools this week to make complaints about inconsiderate and dangerous parking.

Neighbours have reported they cannot leave their properties to collect their children from other local schools as cars have blocked their driveways. They have passed registration numbers of the parked vehicles to the relevant authorities and school. School have contacted our local police and traffic wardens and have been informed that they will be making random visits to Booker Avenue and issuing parking tickets when necessary.

Both the Infant and Junior School would ask that when dropping off and picking up parents do not park on the zig-zag lines, yellow lines or across driveways of houses.
