This is where I go to the toilet and wash my hands.



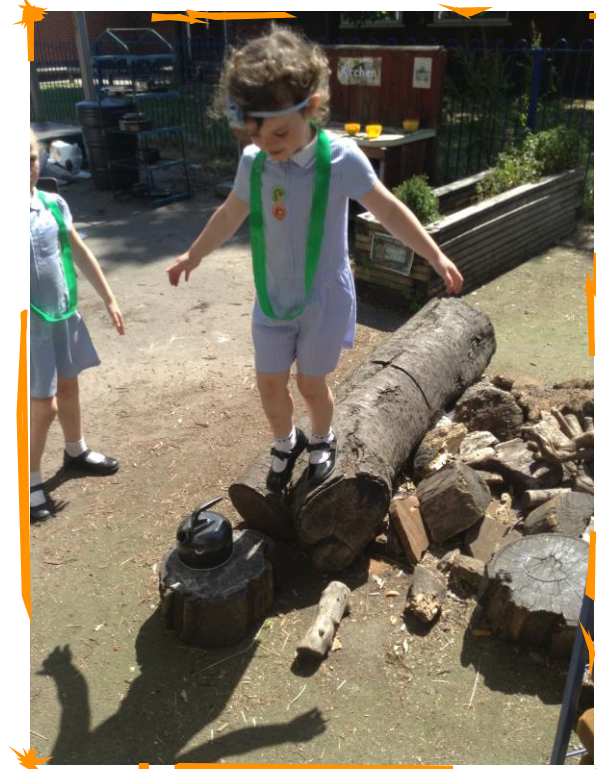
The Paw Patrol sign shows me where the toilets are on the Reception corridor.

This is the hall.



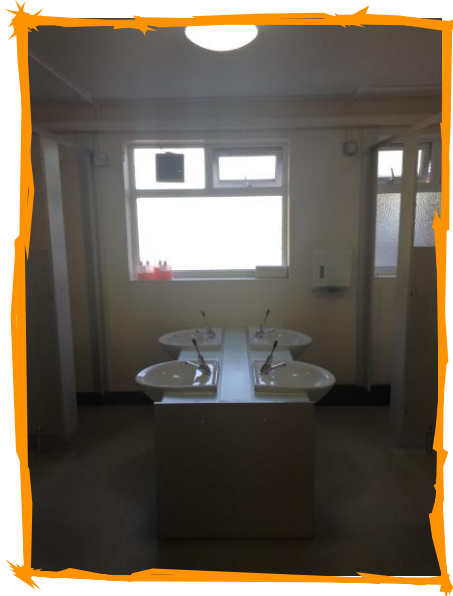
I will eat my dinner in the hall with all my friends. When I am finished, I will put my water bottle away and go outside to play.

This is the lunch time routine.



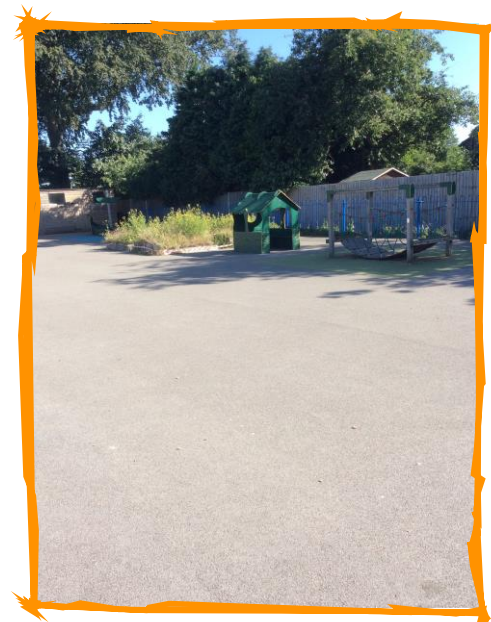
I go to the toilet
