Dear Parents/Carers,

Welcome back after the Autumn break. Halloween and Bonfire Night are behind us, so in an Infant School it must be Christmas! The stage is up ready for our performances! Be prepared for endless Nativity songs, craft activities, glitter and the usual madness that Christmas brings with young children.

Primary School Admission to Reception Class in September 2025

Children who were born between **1st September 2021** and **31st August 2022** whose 5th birthday falls between 1st September 2026 and 31st August 2027, are eligible to start full time education in Reception in September 2026. Parents are advised that they must apply for a Reception class place for their child by **Thursday 15th January 2026**. Parents should apply online at www.liverpool.gov.uk/admissions
